We are asking you to fill in the following sheet giving us some basic information about yourself and telling us, to the extent that you can, what you would like to write about for your paper. Nothing other than your name, class, and whether or not you have had any exposure to Latin is required, but the more information you can give us at this time, the easier it will be to plan the course. CLASS (*e.g.*, “2L”, “LL.M.”, “2G in FAS History”, etc.):

HOW MUCH AND WHAT KIND OF BACKGROUND FOR THIS COURSE HAVE YOU HAD?  
(*E.g.*, “College major in Ancient history”; “Two courses in Ancient literature in translation in college”; “Nothing other than 1L”.)

WHAT LANGUAGES OTHER THAN ENGLISH HAVE YOU HAD SOME EXPOSURE TO?  
(*E.g.*, “college major in Latin”, “speak Spanish with my grandmother”, “nothing.” It’s particularly important that you tell us what, if any, exposure you have had to Latin.)

WHAT IN PARTICULAR LED YOU TO SIGN UP FOR THIS COURSE? (*E.g.*, “I have a lot of background in the field, and I wanted to put the two halves of my life together.” “It looked interesting.” “I needed a Monday course.”)

WHAT DO YOU THINK YOU WOULD LIKE TO WRITE YOUR PAPER ABOUT? (See Suggested Paper Topics List, paying particular attention to the dates. “Don’t know” is a quite acceptable answer at this point, but the more that you can tell us now, without in any way committing yourself, the easier it will be to plan the course.)
