

Linklaters Winter Term India Internship Information Sheet

Dates: January 4th – January 21st

Student Cost: Approximately \$500.

Funding: Linklaters will cover \$2,500 in travel and basic living expenses for each student. Students will be responsible for the remainder. The total trip cost is anticipated to cost \$3,000.

Positions: 10

Program:

The first two and a half weeks will be spent in Mumbai working at an Indian law firm and conducting research for papers. Last year's firms included: Amarchand & Mangaldas and Nishith Desai Associates. The last half a week will be spent visiting an Indian law school in New Delhi. Upon return students will meet with their advisors and discuss their findings. A seminar will be held during the spring semester for students to share their experiences with the HLS community.

Paper Topics:

Paper topics should reflect a necessity of conducting research in India. Each student is required to find a professor to advise their paper before applying to the internship. There are five professors who have committed to advising students: Professors Alford, Nanda, Subramanian, Triantis and Wilkins. Students may also approach other professors.

Winter Term 2009 Paper Topics:

Students on the 2009 trip wrote on a variety of topics. To give you a sense of the type of paper that would be appropriate, here are some examples:

“Stemming the Slowdown of Corporate Deals: An Evaluation of India’s Merger Notification Requirements and Procedures.” By Tara Benedetti

“Choices for Arbitration in India” By Erin Smith Walczewski
